Here is how we will 'partake together' while 'being apart'.

1st. Gather some bread or crackers and grape juice or wine and have them on hand as you watch the video of the service.

2nd. At the appropriate time when the same familiar words are said, then we will all eat the bread and drink the wine.

3rd. It might help to picture yourself sitting in the pews as you worship with those in your household or on your own. It is less about serving or being served and more about receiving the host.

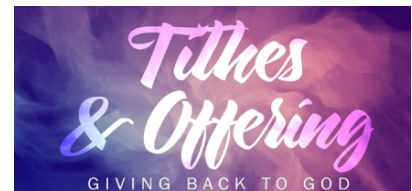
4th. If you don't have grape juice or wine, then most any beverage will do and it doesn't have to be unleavened bread, it can be a saltine or similar. The item is less important than remembering it represents the body and blood of our LORD.

5th. I encourage you to take the times of silence in worship to pray your own prayers as much as what is said on the video. It is your heart that God wants you to speak from not a script.

6th. If you feel uncomfortable with communion at home and not being with others in church, then it is fine for you not to partake. One suggestion for people in that situation is to have a small bowl of water at hand and during the communion service take the water and make the mark of the cross on your own forehead and remember your baptism into the Lord.

The rest is mostly the same as usual.
